TRAFFIC DIVERSION DUE TO SEWER REPAIRS

LAFAYETTE, LA—On Tuesday, September 24, 2024, Lafayette Utilities System (LUS) will begin sewer repairs on the 700 block of Lafayette Street and 600 block of Congress Street. As a result, the southbound lane of Lafayette Street and the westbound side sidewalk, parking spots, and bike lane of Congress Street will be closed. The project will take approximately two weeks to complete – with expected working hours from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

To avoid potential traffic delays, motorists who frequent the affected area are advised to take South Washington Street instead of Lafayette Street or to incorporate additional time into their schedules.
