ELECTRIC, Distributed Generation: Schedule DG

Effective date: Dec. 2025

Ordinance Section: 94-128

Availability:

This rate schedule applies to distributed generation customers as defined in Section 94-210(a). An adjustment factor of 1.1 will be applied to all non-city customers.

Character of Service – Small general service distributed generation:

Service to be furnished under this schedule shall be single-phase or three-phase, at the option of the system, 60-hertz, alternating current (AC), at such voltage as may be mutually agreed upon by the system and the customer. Beginning in July 2025, new commercial distributed generation customers are subject to distributed generation rate as defined in Section 94-210.

Character of Service – Large general service distributed generation:

Service to be furnished under this schedule shall be single-phase or three-phase, at the option of the system, 60-hertz alternating current (AC), at such voltage as may be mutually agreed upon by the system and the customer. Beginning in July 2025, new commercial distributed generation customers are subject to distributed generation rate as defined in Section 94-210.

Monthly rate:

- (1) All electricity supplied to the customer by the system shall be billed under the currently effective rate schedule applicable to that customer.
- (2) All electricity generated and fed back to the system by the customer shall be credited at the system's Avoided Cost credit rate of \$0.0450/kWh.
